HB47 TAX COMPLAINTS-LEGAL ASSISTANCE FOUNDATION (GREENSPAN D) To increase the time within which property tax complaints must be decided and to change the name of the Ohio Legal Assistance Foundation.

HB75 PROPERTY VALUE CONTESTS (MERRIN D) To require local governments that contest property values to formally pass an authorizing resolution for each contest and to notify property owners.

Current Status: 12/11/2019 - PASSED BY HOUSE; Vote 54-39

\* Amended into House Bill 166 by the House. Not included in final bill.

HB91 FAMILY-MEDICAL LEAVE (BOGGS K, BOYD J) To establish family and medical leave insurance benefits.

Current Status: 3/26/2019 - House Insurance, (First Hearing)

HB113 TOWING SPOTTERS (PATTON T) To prohibit a towing service from employing or compensating spotters.

Current Status: 10/2/2019 - Senate Transportation, Commerce and Workforce, (First Hearing)

HB137 EMPLOYEE EARNINGS AND DEDUCTIONS (KELLY B, VITALE N) To require an employer to provide earnings and deductions statements to each of the employer's employees.

Current Status: 9/11/2019 - Referred to Committee Senate Transportation, Commerce and Workforce

HB 166 OPERATING BUDGET (Oelslager, S) To make operating appropriations for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021, and to provide authorization and conditions for the operation of state programs.

Current Status: 7/18/2019 - SIGNED BY GOVERNOR; Eff. Immediately

HB 229 INCOME DISCRIMINATION-HOUSING (Upchurch T, Miller A) To prohibit discrimination in rental housing based on lawful source of income.

Current Status: 5/8/2019 - Referred to Committee House Commerce and Labor

HB 271 SMOKE DETECTOR SAFETY (Baldridge, B) - To amend section 3737.82 and to enact section 3781.21 of the Revised Code to amend the law regarding smoke detectors in residential premises.

Current Status: 6/5/2019 - Referred to Committee House Commerce and Labor

HB 289 ELEVATOR LAW (BALDRIDGE B) To revise the Elevator Law.

Current Status: 11/20/2019 - House Commerce and Labor, (Third Hearing)

HB 351 TERMINATE RENTAL AGREEMENTS (Sobecki, L) - To allow a tenant to terminate a rental agreement if the tenant is a victim of a specified crime.

Current Status: 10/02/2019 Referred to Civil Justice Committee

HB 356 CLEVELAND HOUSING COURT JURISDICTION (Patton, T) - To grant the Cleveland Housing Court jurisdiction in any review or appeal of a final order of an administrative body that relates to a local building, health, or safety code.

Current Status: 12/10/2019 - BILL AMENDED, House Civil Justice, (Fourth Hearing)

HB 357 CLEVELAND MUNICIPAL COURT JURISDICTION (Patton, T) - To grant the Housing Division of the Cleveland Municipal Court concurrent jurisdiction with the Court of Common Pleas in criminal cases related to environmental pollution.

Current Status: 12/10/2019 - BILL AMENDED, House Civil Justice, (Fourth Hearing)

HB 369 SEXUAL, GENDER DISCRIMINATION (Hillyer, Skindell) - To enact the Ohio Fairness Act to prohibit discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation or gender identity or expression, to add mediation as an informal method that the Ohio Civil Rights Commission may use, and to uphold existing religious exemptions under Ohio's Civil Rights Law.

Current Status: 11/19/2019 - House Civil Justice, (First Hearing)

HB 391 STATE MINIMUM WAGE INCREASE (Smith, Sobecki) - To increase the state minimum wage to ten dollars and fifty-five cents per hour beginning January 1, 2021.

Current Status: 11/12/2019 - Referred to Committee House Commerce and Labor

\*New HB 449 REAL ESTATE TRANSFER TAX (Green, Skindell) - To apply the real estate transfer tax to transfers of a controlling interest in a pass-through entity that, directly or indirectly, owns real estate.

SB11 PROHIBIT DISCRIMINATION-SEXUAL ORIENTATION, GENDER IDENTITY (ANTONIO N) To enact the Ohio Fairness Act to prohibit discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation or gender identity or expression, to add mediation as an informal method that the Ohio Civil Rights Commission may use, and to uphold existing religious exemptions under Ohio's Civil Rights Law.

Current Status: 5/22/2019 - Senate Judiciary, (Third Hearing)

SB36 FEDERALLY SUBSIDIZED RENTAL PROPERTY VALUATION (HUFFMAN M) To prescribe how federally subsidized residential rental property must be valued for property tax purposes.

Current Status: 4/2/2019 - Senate Ways and Means, (Third Hearing)

SB 86 UTILITY SERVICE RESELLERS (MAHARATH T) To regulate certain resellers of utility service.

Current Status: 12/10/2019 - Senate Energy and Public Utilities, (Third Hearing)

SB 91 FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE (MAHARATH T) To establish family and medical leave insurance benefits.

Current Status: 9/25/2019 - Senate Insurance and Financial Institutions, (First Hearing)

SB 96 CLEVELAND HOUSING COURT (DOLAN M, YUKO K) To grant the Cleveland Housing Court jurisdiction in any review or appeal of a final order of an administrative body that relates to a local building, health, or safety code.

Current Status: 11/6/2019 - Senate Judiciary, (Third Hearing)

SB 103 GRANT CONCURRENT JURISDICTION-POLLUTION (DOLAN M, YUKO K) To grant the Housing Division of the Cleveland Municipal Court concurrent jurisdiction with the Court of Common Pleas in criminal cases related to environmental pollution.

Current Status: 12/11/2019 - PASSED BY SENATE; Vote 31-0

SB 127 ELEVATOR LAW (Uecker J, Yuko K) To revise the Elevator Law.

Current Status: 5/8/2019 - Senate Transportation, Commerce and Workforce, (First Hearing)

SB 149 EMPLOYEE WAGE HISTORY (MAHARATH T) To prohibit employers from seeking a prospective employee's wage or salary history.

Current Status: 9/11/2019 - Referred to Committee Senate Transportation, Commerce and Workforce
